Documentary – Resilience: The Biology of Stress & The Science of Hope

Resilience is a one-hour documentary that delves in the science of adverse childhood experiences (ACE) and the birth of a new movement to treat and prevent the stress that is the consequence. The documentary explores how extremely stressful experiences in childhood can alter brain development and have lifelong effects on health and behaviour.

As experts and practitioners profiled in *Resilience* are proving, what is predictable is preventable. The documentary explores ideas and solutions with physicians, educators, social workers and communities who are striving to break the cycles of adversity and disease. This film is relevant to our understanding of the early life events that contribute to social exclusion including homelessness.

Building Community Support For Crisis, Social & Affordable Housing

This session helps participants to develop their skills and frameworks for actively building community support for crisis, social and affordable housing. The session offers a methodology for working proactively over time to engage communities positively with the goal of reducing the risk of local opposition. The methodology aims to strengthen the mandate for solutions to homelessness and housing need.

The methodology is relevant to the challenge of locating and sustaining crisis, social and affordable housing and by extension, is relevant to the question of how to create and sustain any services responsive to the needs of vulnerable people. Participants will leave the session with the tools necessary to build a strategy for their organisation and to also work collaboratively with other regional organisations to build active community support.
