Supported Place Application

Thanks to the generous support of the Salvation Army, the National Homelessness Conference 2020 is offering a limited number of supported registrations for people with a lived experience to attend this year's conference.

The conference committee is seeking applications from throughout Australia and from across the spectrum of people known to experience homelessness. This includes women who have experienced domestic and family violence, young people, Aboriginal people, older people, people from culturally and linguistically diverse people, people from regional and remote locations and people who identify as LGBTIQ. We also encourage applications from people who have experienced different forms of homelessness such as rough sleeping and couch surfing.

The applications will be considered by Homelessness Australia to ensure people with a range of experiences of experiences of homelessness can participate in the conference.

There will be three (3) places per state and territory.

Application notes

- Supported places includes conference registration.
- Applicants can submit their application for a supported place directly to a homelessness peak body (see below) or through homelessness or other support services who must submit the application the homelessness peak.
- If applying directly, you are responsible for ensuring you have access to internet connection and a device to access the online conference
- Nominating organisations (not the peak body receiving the application) are responsible for ensuring the applicant has access to the necessary technology to be able to access the online conference
- Applications close on Friday 13 November 2020
- Applicants will be advised within one week of application date.




